

JUNIOR SPRING/AUTUMN POINT SCORES – NOR

1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 6 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Racing is open to the following classes:
- Optimists
 - Pittwater Juniors
 - O'pen BICs
 - Laser 4.7s
 - Manly Juniors
 - Flying 11s
- 2.2 Boats must hold a current "Off the Beach" Boat Registration and Compliance Declaration.
- 2.3 A class must be constituted by a minimum of 3 boats.

3. Fees

- 3.1 There is no entry fee for junior classes.

4. Schedule

- 4.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.8, MYC Calendar.
- 4.2 Races are either Handicap Races or Pursuit Races.

5. Racing Area

- 5.1 Racing will be conducted in North Harbour and Manly Cove.

6. Further Information

- 6.1 A BBQ, presentation and get together will be held on the deck of MYC after racing.

JUNIOR SPRING/AUTUMN POINT SCORES – SI

1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 6 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.

2. Schedule of Races

- 2.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.8, MYC Calendar.
- 2.2 Point Score races may be run as the same race as a Club Championship race, in which case the Club Championship Sailing Instructions apply other than for scoring.
- 2.3 All races are Handicap Races with a Scratch Start, unless otherwise advised at the pre-race briefing that the races may be Pursuit Races.
- 2.4 The classes/divisions to be sailed will be determined by the eligible boats registered.
- 2.5 There will be a pre-race briefing on the MYC Rigging deck at 1315 hrs.
- 2.6 The classes to be sailed will be announced at the pre-race briefing.
- 2.7 The handicap or start time of each boat shall be allocated during the pre-race briefing.

3. Class Flags

- 3.1 The class flags will be as follows:

| CLASS | FLAG |
|------------------|------------------------------------|
| Optimist | Numeral Pennant 1 |
| Pittwater Junior | Numeral Pennant 2 |
| O'pen BIC | Numeral Pennant 3 |
| Manly Junior | Numeral Pennant 4 |
| Flying 11 | Numeral Pennant 5 |
| Laser 4.7 | Green flag with a Red Laser emblem |

4. The Courses

- 4.1 Courses are shown in Appendix A1.

5. The Start

- 5.1 The start will be on the Committee Boat line as described in Section 6 General Conditions of Racing.
- 5.2 The earliest start for the first junior boat will be 1415 hrs.
- 5.3 For Pursuit Races, a countdown may be given from the Committee boat as explained in the pre-race briefing.

6. The Finish

- 6.1 The finish will be on the Committee Boat line as described in Section 6 General Conditions of Racing.

7. Time Limits

- 7.1 The time limit for each race shall be 90 minutes or shorter at the discretion of the Race Committee.

8. Penalty System

- 8.1 If an arbitrated penalty is accepted, it shall be a scoring penalty of 50% of the difference between her non-penalized score and the score for DSQ. Half points shall be rounded up and the points of the other boats shall not be adjusted.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 The number of races scheduled for the series is shown in Section 5.8, MYC Calendar.
- 9.2 A boat's series score is the total of her race scores, with her worst 2 scores discarded.
- 9.3 The number of races required to constitute a series will be 4 less than the number of races scheduled in the series.
