RISK WARNING AND CONSENT

This RISK WARNING is issued jointly by Manly Yacht Club and Roads and Maritime Services, pursuant to the Civil Liberty Act 2002 to all persons wishing to participate in the sailing activities conducted by Manly Yacht Club.

Participants are warned that, regardless of the precautions, which might be taken by reasonable and experienced persons, sailing can be a dangerous pursuit and participants are exposed to significant risk of property damage, physical harm and possible death.

As an indication, these risks may include, but are not limited to:

- The extremes of weather and sea conditions.
- The potential that control of vessels may be lost, resulting in collision with objects and other vessels.
- The sudden movement of the vessel at any time and the possibility that participants may fall or be thrown overboard, resulting in drowning.
- The possibility that participants may be injured by equipment on the vessel.
- The absence of immediate medical care and the likelihood that significant delays may occur before medical care is available.
- Exposure to the elements for extended periods.

Manly Yacht Club and Roads and Maritime Services also warn participants that regardless of their best intentions, they may be unable to render assistance to participants who are in distress.

Manly Yacht Club reminds participants that when sailing, really serious injuries of the type that can cause permanent disablement or even death are statistically very rare but can and do occur. As with any water sport, the possibility of drowning is also present. While for many sailing activities a patrol boat might be present, the boat cannot be everywhere at once, cannot observe every incident that occurs and may not always recognise an observed incident as being a serious one requiring immediate response. First aid or medical assistance is not always available.

Manly Yacht Club further reminds participants and visitors to be cognisant of slip, trip, cut and moving

object hazards in Manly Yacht Club environs, including buildings, storage areas, rigging deck, jetty, pontoon and launching ramps.

Participants are warned to consider the above risks and all other risks before deciding to participate in any sailing event with Manly Yacht Club.

Note Well: Although Manly Yacht Club is covered by third party liability insurance, **this cover DOES NOT extend to participants.**

A personal accident insurance policy is provided with membership of Yachting NSW. Membership of Manly Yacht Club includes membership to Yachting NSW and it is a requirement of race entry that all crew of more than 3 races, have Yachting NSW or similar membership.

You can help reduce risk to yourself by always following these guidelines:

- Wear footwear while sailing or on Manly Yacht Club premises.
- Wear a life vest and adequate sun protection.
- Bring drinking water along to sailing activities.
- Examine launching ramps before using them to see how slippery they are.
- Check the weather forecast before going sailing.
- Follow the directions of your Instructors.
- Do not run or skylark, especially on the jetty, pontoon and launching ramps.
- Beware of flapping sails or moving spars.

I also acknowledge that neither The Manly Yacht Club nor any official volunteer or member shall be under any liability for any loss or damage to personal property which may be suffered or incurred by me or the minors for whom I am responsible.

All sailing dinghies in racks at Manly Yacht Club will become liable for race entry fees for their individual division in addition to the rack fee.

Any unregistered, un-financial or inactive boats will be liable for removal.

- I agree to pay tender storage fees.
- I understand and accept that failure to comply with the above renders my dinghy/tender liable to removal at the discretion of Manly Yacht Club, without compensation of any kind.
- I am a financial member of Manly Yacht Club.
- I have read and accept the Conditions of Boat Storage on this form.

CONDITIONS OF BOAT STORAGE

All boats are stored at Manly Yacht Club in accordance with the following conditions:

1. Boat storage is only available to senior, syndicate or family memberships of Manly Yacht Club.
2. Boats are stored at the owner's risk. Manly Yacht Club accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to boats stored at the club.
3. Boats must be stored in locations as directed by the Club Captain. The Club Captain may change such locations from time to time.
4. Priority for storage will be given to those who commit to regular racing with the MYC fleet. At the discretion of the Club Captain, their boats will be located in the more easily accessed positions. Boats that do not race may be asked to vacate at any time to make room for boats that do race.
5. Club lasers have dedicated storage lockers containing the necessary equipment for each boat (colour coded) and dedicated mast racks. Members who use club lasers must use the dedicated equipment and replace it in the dedicated locker and rack after use.
6. Boats and oars must have their owner's name and contact telephone number clearly displayed.
7. Boats must not be left unattended on the wharf or rigging deck other than in their allocated storage location.
8. Oars must not be stored with dinghies and must be stored in the oar locker.
9. Fuel must not be stored at Manly Yacht Club.
10. Boat owners must advise Manly Yacht Club of their address and contact telephone details and notify Manly Yacht Club in writing of change of address and contact telephone number.
11. Failure to comply with these conditions may cause the boat to be removed from Manly Yacht Club. Such removal shall be at the risk of the owner.
12. It is the responsibility of the boat owner to ensure that storage and membership fees are paid promptly and on demand.
13. If boat storage fees are not paid promptly and on demand the boat, and any associated equipment; may be sold by Manly Yacht Club and the proceeds of the sale used to meet unpaid fees. Any excess monies may be posted to the boat owner at the last notified address. Manly Yacht Club shall not be responsible to maximize the sale proceeds or for any loss occasioned by a failure of the boat owner to have notified a correct and up-to-date address.
