1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 6 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Entry is open to mono hull sailing yachts with length overall from 6m to 10m or at the Race Committee's discretion.
- 2.2 Boats must hold a Category 7 Equipment Audit Form.

3. Fees

- 3.1 Entry fees are listed in Section 5.1, Racing Fees in the MYC Handbook.

4. Schedule

- 4.1 Racing is held over 2 x non-consecutive days as shown in Section 5.8, MYC Calendar.
- 4.2 The following classes will be sailed:
 - Yachts
- 4.3 There are up to 5 Handicap Races scheduled for each day.

- 5.1 Racing will be conducted in Manly Cove and North Harbour.

1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 6 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.

2. Schedule of Races

- 2.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.8, MYC Calendar.
- 2.2 The following classes will be sailed:
- Yachts
- 2.3 There are up to 5 Handicap Races scheduled for each race day.
- 2.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal of the first race of each race day is 10:55
- 2.5 When more than one race will be held on the same day, the warning signal for each succeeding race will be made as soon as practicable after the finish of the previous race.

3. Class Flags

- 3.1 The class flags will be as follows:

CLASS	FLAG
Yachts	Numeral Pennant 1

4. The Courses

- 4.1 The courses are shown in Appendix A12.

5. The Start

- 5.1 The start will be on the Committee Boat line as described in Section 6 General Conditions of Racing.

6. The Finish

- 6.1 The finish will be on the Committee Boat line as described in Section 6 General Conditions of Racing.

7. Time Limits

- 7.1 The time limit for each race will be 60 minutes.
- 7.2 Boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat finishes will be scored DNF without a hearing.
- 7.3 No races will be started after 1600 hours.

8. Penalty System

- 8.1 If an arbitrated penalty is accepted, it shall be a scoring penalty of 50% of the difference between a boat's non-penalized score and the score for DSQ. Half points shall be rounded up and the points of the other boats shall not be adjusted.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 The PHS Handicap system will be used to score a boat's result and adjust her handicap.
- 9.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with no excluded scores.
- 9.3 The number of races required to constitute a series is 6.

10. Further Information

- 10.1 A BBQ and presentation will be held on the MYC balcony after racing.
