

YACHT CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP – NOR

1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 6 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Racing is open to the following classes:
- Mono hull yachts whose length overall is greater than 6m and less than 20m
- 2.2 Yachts must hold a Category 7 Equipment Audit Form.
- 2.3 A division must be constituted by a minimum of four yachts.
- 2.4 Yachts may only compete in the Club Championships using the nominated helm(s). Written notice of changes to helm may be considered by the Race Director.

3. Fees

- 3.1 Entry fees are listed in Section 5.1, Racing Fees in the MYC Handbook.

4. Schedule

- 4.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.8 MYC Calendar.
- 4.2 There is 1 Handicap Race scheduled for each division per day.
- 4.3 The following divisions will be sailed:
- Yachts - Division 1
 - Yachts - Division 2

5. Racing Area

- 5.1 Racing will be conducted within Sydney Harbour.

6. Further Information

- 6.1 A BBQ, presentation and get together will be held on the MYC balcony after racing.

YACHT CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP – SI

1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 6 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.

2. Schedule of Races

- 2.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.8 MYC Calendar.
- 2.2 There is 1 Handicap Race scheduled for each division per day.
- 2.3 The following divisions will be sailed:
- Yachts - Division 1
 - Yachts - Division 2
- 2.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for each class or division is shown below (to be read in conjunction with RRS 26). Races will be started no earlier than times shown. Times shall be taken from visual signals; the failure of a sound signal shall be disregarded.

| 1245 hrs | Yachts - Division 2 | Numeral Pennant 2 |
| 1255 hrs | Yachts - Division 1 | Numeral Pennant 1 |

3. Class Flags

- 3.1 The class flags will be as follows:

| CLASS | FLAG |
|---------------------|-------------------|
| Yachts – Division 1 | Numeral Pennant 1 |
| Yachts – Division 2 | Numeral Pennant 2 |

4. The Courses

- 4.1 Courses for Yachts – Division 1 are shown in Appendix A3.
- 4.2 Courses for Yachts – Division 2 are shown in Appendix A4.

5. The Start

- 5.1 The start will be on the Committee Boat line as described in Section 6 General Conditions of Racing.

6. The Finish

- 6.1 The finish will be on either the Committee Boat line or the Clubhouse Triangles as described in Section 6 General Conditions of Racing.

7. Time Limits

- 7.1 Subject to 7.2 and 7.3 **Error! Reference source not found.**, the time limit for yachts shall be 1700 hours.
- 7.2 If a race is postponed for any reason the time limit will be extended by the length of the postponement or for 30 minutes whichever is the less.
- 7.3 If the first boat in a division finishes within 30 minutes of the time limit then the time limit shall be extended by 30 minutes from the finishing time of the first boat for that division or to 1730 hours whichever is soonest.

8. Penalty System

- 8.1 If an arbitrated penalty is accepted, it shall be a scoring penalty of 50% of the difference between a boat's non-penalized score and the score for DSQ. Half points shall be rounded up and the points of the other boats shall not be adjusted.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 The PHS Handicap system will be used to score a boat's result and adjust her handicap.
- 9.2 The number of races scheduled for the series is shown in Section 5.8 MYC Calendar.
- 9.3 The number of races required to constitute a series will be 4 less than the number of races scheduled in the series.
- 9.4 When from 9 to 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her series scores excluding her worst 2 scores.
- 9.5 When fewer than 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her series scores excluding her worst 1 score.
