

JUNIOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP – NOR

1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 6 of the MYC Handbook and any applicable class/association rules, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Racing is open to Junior classes:
- Optimist
 - Pittwater Junior
 - O'pen BIC
 - Laser 4.7
 - Manly Junior
 - Flying 11
- 2.2 Boats must hold a current "Off the Beach" Boat Registration and Compliance Declaration.
- 2.3 A class must be constituted by a minimum of 3 boats.

3. Fees

- 3.1 There is no entry fee for junior classes.

4. Schedule

- 4.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.8 MYC Calendar.
- 4.2 All races are Scratch Races.
- 4.3 Races are scored as part of the following series:
- Spring and Autumn Point Score, Club Championships for Junior Classes.
- 4.4 The classes/divisions to be sailed will be determined by the eligible boats registered.
- 4.5 Boats may only compete in the Club Championships using the nominated helm(s). Written notice of changes to helm may be considered by the Race Director.

5. Racing Area

- 5.1 Racing will be conducted in North Harbour & Manly Cove.

JUNIOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP – SI

1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 6 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.

2. Schedule of Races

- 2.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.8 MYC Calendar.
 2.2 All Races are Scratch Races.
 2.3 There will be a pre-race briefing on the MYC Rigging deck at 1315 hrs.
 2.4 The classes to be sailed will be announced at the pre-race briefing.
 2.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the earliest race is 1415 hrs.
 2.6 The order of the classes/divisions to be sailed will be announced during the pre-race briefing.
 2.7 When more than one race will be held on the same day, the warning signal for each succeeding race will be made as soon as practicable after the finish of the previous race.

3. Class Flags

- 3.1 The class flags will be as follows:

CLASS	FLAG
Optimist	Numeral Pennant 1
Pittwater Junior	Numeral Pennant 2
O'pen BIC	Numeral Pennant 3
Manly Junior	Numeral Pennant 4
Flying 11	Numeral Pennant 5
Laser 4.7	Green flag with a Red Laser emblem

4. The Courses

- 4.1 Courses are shown in Appendix A1.

5. The Start

- 5.1 The start will be on the Committee Boat line as described in Section 6 General Conditions of Racing.

6. The Finish

- 6.1 The finish will be on the Committee Boat line as described in Section 6 General Conditions of Racing.

7. Time Limits

- 7.1 The time limit for each race is 90 minutes or shorter at the discretion of the Race Committee.

8. Penalty System

- 8.1 If an arbitrated penalty is accepted, it shall be a scoring penalty of 50% of the difference between her non-penalized score and the score for DSQ. Half points shall be rounded up and the points of the other boats shall not be adjusted.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 The number of races scheduled for the series is shown in Section 5.8 MYC Calendar.
 9.2 Each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, with her worst 2 scores discarded.
 9.3 The number of races required to constitute a series will be 4 less than the number of races scheduled in the series.
