1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 7 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Racing is open to the following classes:
- Mono hull yachts whose length overall is greater than 6m and less than 20m
- 2.2 Yachts must hold a Category 7 Equipment Audit Form.

3. Fees

- 3.1 Entry fees are listed in Section 5.1, Racing Fees in the MYC Handbook.

4. Schedule

- 4.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.7 MYC Calendar.
- 4.2 The following classes/divisions will be sailed:
- Yachts - Division 1
- 4.3 There is 1 Allocated Start Time – Handicap Race scheduled for each day.

5. Racing Area

- 5.1 Racing will be conducted within Sydney Harbour.

6. Further Information

- 6.1 A BBQ and presentation will be held on the MYC balcony after racing.

1. Rules

1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 7 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.

2. Schedule of Races

- 2.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.7 MYC Calendar.
- 2.2 The following classes/divisions will be sailed:
 - Yachts - Division 1
- 2.3 There is 1 Allocated Start Time – Handicap Race scheduled for each day.

3. Class Flags

3.1 The class flags will be as follows:

4. The Courses

4.1 Courses for Yachts – Summer Series will use Summer Series courses as shown in Appendix A7.

5. The Start

- 5.1 The start will be on the Committee Boat line as described in Section 7 General Conditions of Racing.
- 5.2 The earliest start for the first yacht will be 1230 hrs.

6. The Finish

- 6.1 The finish will be on either the Committee Boat line or the Clubhouse Triangles as described in Section 7 General Conditions of Racing.

7. Time Limits

- 7.1 The time limit for the yachts will be 1700 hours.
7.2 If the first boat in finishes between 1630 hours and 1700 hours the time limit shall be extended by 30 minutes from the finishing time of the first boat.

8. Penalty System

- 8.1 If an arbitrated penalty is accepted, it shall be a scoring penalty of 50% of the difference between a boat's non-penalized score and the score for DSQ. Half points shall be rounded up and the points of the other boats shall not be adjusted.

9. Scoring

- 1.1 The PHS Handicap system will be used to score a boat's result and adjust her handicap.
1.2 The elapsed time is from the Allocated start time to the yachts finish time.
1.3 When 7 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her series scores excluding her worst 2 scores.
1.4 When fewer than 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her series scores excluding her worst 1 score.
1.5 The number of races scheduled for the series is shown in Section 5.7 MYC Calendar.
1.6 The number of races required to constitute a series will be 3 less than the number of races scheduled in the series.
1.7 A boats Allocated Start Time may be adjusted for any race.

10. Prizes

- 10.1 Grand prizes will be drawn from the 'barrel' on the last day of racing in the series.

11. Further Information

- 11.1 A BBQ and presentation will be held on the MYC balcony after racing.
