

YACHT WINTER SERIES – NOR

1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 7 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Entry is open to mono hull sailing yachts with length overall from 6m to 20m or at the Race Committee's discretion.
- 2.2 Boats must hold a Category 7 Equipment Audit Form.

3. Fees

- 3.1 Entry fees are listed in Section 5.1, Racing Fees in the MYC Handbook.

4. Schedule

- 4.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.7 MYC Calendar.
- 4.2 The following classes/divisions will be sailed:
- Yachts – Division 1
 - Yachts – Division 2
- 4.3 There is 1 Pursuit Race scheduled for each division per day.

5. Racing Area

- 5.1 Racing will be conducted within Sydney Harbour.

6. Further Information

- 6.1 A BBQ and presentation will be held on the MYC balcony after racing.



YACHT WINTER SERIES – SI

1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 7 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions which are also considered part of the rules.

2. Schedule of Races

- 2.1 The schedule of race days is shown in Section 5.7 MYC Calendar.
 2.2 The following classes/divisions will be sailed:
 • Yachts – Division 1 and Division 2
 2.3 There is 1 Pursuit Race scheduled for each class/division per day.
 2.4 The earliest start for the first boat will be 1200 hrs.

3. Class Flags

- 3.1 The class flags will be as follows:

CLASS	FLAG
Yachts – Division 1	Numeral Pennant 1
Yachts – Division 2	Numeral Pennant 2

4. The Courses

- 4.1 Courses for division 1 are shown in Appendix A10.
 4.2 Courses for division 2 are shown in Appendix A11.

5. The Start

- 5.1 All races will be Pursuit starts from the Clubhouse Triangles as described in Section 7 General Conditions of Racing.

6. The Finish

- 6.1 The finish will be on the Clubhouse Triangles as described in Section 7 General Conditions of Racing.

7. Time Limits

- 7.1 The time limit for all races will be 1630 hours.

8. Penalty System

- 8.1 If an arbitrated penalty is accepted, it shall be a scoring penalty of 50% of the difference between a boat's non-penalized score and the score for DSQ. Half points shall be rounded up and the points of the other boats shall not be adjusted.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 When from 5 to 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her series scores excluding her worst 1 score.
 9.2 A boat will receive a Back Calculated Handicap (BCH), which is the handicap that she would have needed to give her the same finish time as the first boat that finished after 40% of the fleet.
 9.3 A boat's handicap for the next race in the series will be the average of their allocated handicap and their BCH, clipped so that it may not change by more than 5% of their handicap adjusted elapsed time.
 9.4 A boat's handicap cannot be adjusted to be earlier than the earliest start for all boats.

10. Prizes

- 10.1 Grand prizes will be drawn from the 'barrel' on the last day of racing in the series.

11. Further Information

- 11.1 A BBQ and presentation will be held on the MYC balcony after racing.
