



## WOMEN'S CHALLENGE – NOR

### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The racing will be governed by the General Conditions of Racing as defined by Section 6 of the MYC Handbook, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions, which are also considered part of the rules.
- 1.2 The Organising Authority may amend This Notice of Race. Amendments made prior to the race date will be published on the web site. Amendments thereafter shall be published on the Official Notice Board, located on the ground floor foyer of MYC

### 2. Advertising

- 2.1 All races are in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
- 2.2 If provided, competitors shall carry and display any event promotional material at all times while competing.
- 2.3 Competitors not displaying promotional material that may be provided are ineligible to race.
- 2.4 Promotional material may be available for collection at MYC. Competitors will be advised by the Race Director.
- 2.5 In the event that competitors are unable to collect promotional material at that time, competitors should contact the Race Director to make other arrangements for collection.

### 3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 Racing is open to the following:
  - Mono hull yachts whose length overall is greater than 6m and less than 20m
  - Lasers
  - Junior Classes
  - Access Dinghies
- 3.2 Yachts must hold a Category 7 Equipment Audit Form.
- 3.3 Lasers, Junior Classes and Access Dinghies must hold a current "Off the Beach" Boat Registration and Compliance Declaration.
- 3.4 A division must be constituted by a minimum of three boats.
- 3.5 Boats must have a female helm. Some divisions also require all female crew.

### 4. Fees

- 4.1 Yacht entry fee is \$60 for both MYC members and non-MYC members.
- 4.2 Laser and Access Dinghy entry fee is \$20 for both MYC members and non-MYC members.
- 4.3 Junior Classes and juniors entry fee is free.



## 5. Schedule

- 5.1 Racing for junior classes, access dinghies and lasers is scheduled for Saturday, 18th March 2017.
- 5.2 Racing for all other classes is scheduled for Sunday 19th March 2017.
- 5.3 The following classes will be sailed:

- 5.4 If insufficient entries are received for a given class, the Race Director may choose to combine classes. If classes are combined, then an amendment to the Sailing Instructions will be published.
- 5.5 There is one race scheduled for yachts and access dinghies. Up to two races are scheduled for junior classes and lasers.
- 5.6 All races will be scratch starts from the Committee Boat line as described in Section 6 General Conditions of Racing.

## 6. Sailing Instructions

- 6.1 The Sailing Instructions are available on the MYC website [www.myc.org.au](http://www.myc.org.au) at least 1 week prior to the event.

## 7. Racing Area

- 7.1 Racing will be conducted within Sydney Harbour. Lasers, junior classes and access dinghies will sail in North Harbour.

## 8. Further Information

- 8.1 A presentation and light refreshments will be held on the upper deck of the MYC after racing.
