

NOTICE OF ALTERATION TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

FOR MYC Pittwater Race Friday 30th March 2018

Competitors please be advised of the following alteration to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

AMENDMENT NO.1

ADD 5.3

5.3 The racing rules will be modified in accordance with Rule 86 as follows: The MYC General conditions of sailing section 6.9.1 may change at the discretion of the RO.

If at the nominated time of the first warning signal the CV displays the AP and Flag L with 2 sound signals the CV will move to an alternate starting area.

The AP and Flag L will be removed with a sound signal 1 minute before the Warning.

The start line shall be between the CV staff carrying the MYC burgee and an adjacent mark on the port side. The adjacent mark may be a MYC mark or any other mark which will be announced to boats on the Race Channel.

The CV may or may not be anchored.

A boat identified as OCS by virtue of the CV drifting shall not be grounds for redress. This amends RRS 60
