Audi Sydney Harbour Regatta (The Rat Run)

The Audi Sydney Harbour Regatta was held again this year, on the 3rd and 4th of March. 277 boats entered in 21 divisions. All except the Sydney 38s raced inside the harbour on courses varying from windward leeward, to short harbour courses.

The club had 11 boats competing; Jim Nixon in Carinya was defending his title won last year in the classics division, Big Blue, San Toy, Melody, Morna, Cuckoo's Nest, Pam, Wild Life, Beau Soleil, Crow Bar and Ratty.

Saturday dawned a beautiful day with Racing starting at 1200 in a good 10 - 15knot nor-easter. Ratty was in the White Sail Division....I know you are all thinking that we have a black sail, but evidently this is the new trendy way of saying non spinnaker. Our course was around the sound which seemed great until we realized that it was the same racing area as the div 1 and 2 boats.....Wild Oats, Yendis, Wot Yot etc. all 50 - 60 feet long. The pre-race manoeuvring was pretty hectic with probably 60 plus boats running up and down the line.

Ratty with crew Barbara Jones (Regular) Peter and Karen from Top Odds, and Roger Wright (regular Wednesday crew) had a great race taking every opportunity we could to tack onto starboard in front of the mega yachts, hanging on and waiting to see what eventuated.....the big guy's were all very polite and I don't think we got shouted at once. Each race has a 2 hour time limit, and as we were fighting way out of our weight division we finished the first race with only 2 minutes to spare.

Race 2, with 2 minutes to the gun saw one of our competitors T-Bone out a moth (who were racing in and around our start linewith 60 big boats milling around waiting for their start made for some exciting moments!) so we tacked around to make sure the broken Moth was ok and consequently missed the start by a bit. Subsequently I felt we spent the rest of race trying to catch up. The breeze got up to a healthy 20 plus knots and at one stage I looked around to see more wrapped and out of control spinnakers on the harbour than I have seen before.....Oh to be a sailmaker on Monday morning. Anyway we finished race 2 with 3 _ minutes to spare.

We left the mooring Sunday believing we had in a tenuous third place in our division and spent the ensuing 3 _ hours wallowing around the sound getting really excited when the breeze would lift to 2.5 knots. Racing in the sound was abandoned at about 1445 and we congratulated ourselves on a great third place.

On arrival back at Middle Harbour Barb and I were greeted by hearty congratulations from Kaotic whom we believed to be the winners.....An overnight recount had put Ratty into first and Kaotic second. A nice surprise!

The winners of each division had to be out at Eastern Creek Raceway (yes that's Eastern Creek.....just this side of Penrith) by 0930 the following day to race 2 Audi TT's around the skid pan (a concrete thing that looks like a car park and probably is on busy days). Barb and I went out for two events. First was ripping around a small race track in the wet as quickly as we could go and then stopping

MYC featured prominently in this years Audi Regatta with Vice President Ian Dennewald taking out first place in the White Sail Division with Ratty, but hard luck, he didn't win the car. Eleven club yachts participated, including the Clubs very own yacht Melody. Graham (Wishbone) Radford had bad luck. Right at the start of the first race a careless yacht managed to stick the top of its mast right through the one and only sail on San Toy. Unfortunately the second day was a complete drifter and racing was abandoned.

Melody was involved in another dramatic event when she broke her mooring and ended up on the beach dangerously close to the sea wall. Jim Nixon was first on the scene in his wet suit and with assistance from a passing backpacker they stood waist deep in water and held her off. Meanwhile Bruce Davis and I chugged over from Davis Marina in the Runaround with a towline. Melody was pulled off and suffered no damage.

Nina is a 10 year old girl who suffers from EPILEPSY. She has multiple seizures everyday and even though these are not always visible, each one does more damage to her brain. Regularly, Nina suffers major seizures that are not only visible but require her to be resuscitated.

One such seizure caused Nina to loose her speech at age 4. Nina urgently needs treatment in the United States. We are fund raising to assist Nina's mother, a Middle Harbour Yacht Club sailor, with the cost of that treatment in the US, which you know is very expensive.

Nina visited the US last year and received some life-changing treatment. With new medication, she has now started to talk and enjoy the life of a 10 year old. Nina needs to return to the US because her body can no longer sustain the continued use of her current medication.

Near-full recovery is only possible with a surgical technique called Multiple Sub-Pial Transection, "MST", which is only carried out for this type of epilepsy in a few centres in the world.

This surgery, if undertaken after further assessment, needs to be done before Nina turns 12 years old, when the brain reaches full maturity.

It is likely that an Australian surgeon will go to the Rush Medical Centre at the same time as Nina and bring back the techniques which will help other Australian children like Nina.

Again, this was a huge day, with 20 students from Fisher Rd and Truscott St Special schools taking advantage of a very special day on the water in a very special setting.

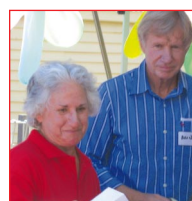

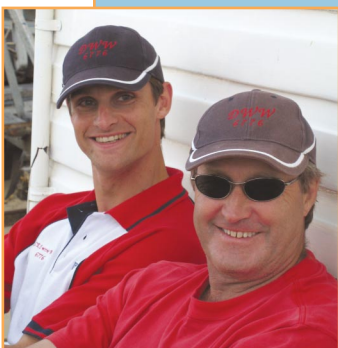
