

9. PHS Handicaps

- 9.1 The Handicap (HC) assigned to a Junior for the Performance Handicapping System (PHS) is a 4-decimal number. The elapsed time will be multiplied by HC to get a corrected time.
- 9.2 After each race, a Race Time Correction Factor (TCF) will be computed for each boat such that if each boat's Race TCF was applied to its elapsed time for that race, all boats would have finished at the same corrected time as the reference boat. The reference boat is usually the boat that finishes about 40% of the way through the fleet on elapsed time. If a boat fails to finish, no TCF is calculated. For each competitor, the Race TCF = Reference Time / Competitor's Elapsed Time
- 9.3 The Race TCF will have an upper and a lower clamp of 5% when compared to its previous TCF.
- 9.4 The Handicaps are adjusted as follows:
 - Race 1 will be set by the Race Director after considering previous TCFs and any advice from Instructors.
 - Race 2 will be the average of the HC for Race 1 and the TCF for Race 1.
 - Race 3 will be the average of the HC for Race 1 and the TCFs for Races 1 and 2.
 - Race 4 will be the average of the TCFs for Races 1, 2 and 3.
 - A boat's HC for a subsequent race will be the average of the last four TCFs.
